I am directed to state that based on the consultations with the concerned State Govt., the concerned affiliating body and on recommendations of the Regional Committee, the Expert Committee constituted by the Council and as per the provisions of AICTE Act and Regulations, the All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), is pleased to accord approval to MOTILAL KANHAIYALAL FOMRA CHARITABLE TRUST, FOMRA BUILDING NO.123, GOVINDAPPA NAICK STREET, CHENNAI-600 001, for establishment of SHREE MOTILAL KANHAIYALAL FORMA INSTT. The admission will be made in accordance with Regulations notified by the AICTE vide GSR 476(E) dated 20.05.1994 based on the Hon'ble Supreme Court Judgement dated 04.02.1993 with regard to W.P(C) No. 607 of 1992 in the case of Unni Krishnan J.P and others etc. V.s. The Society may decide to send an Expert Committee or authorise any officer of AICTE including  
Approved by the Society to verify the compliance of the conditions as laid down and any other specific  
conditions to make necessary approval to the conduct of the  
approved courses.

In case of any information furnished in written form or otherwise to the Society in the event of any information is  
found to be false, misleading or untrue it will be liable to withdraw its approval to the conduct of the  
approved courses of Classes I & II of AICTE Regulations.

In the event of non-compliance of the Society with regard to the above Regulations, Guidelines,  
terms and conditions laid down by AICTE from time to time, the AICTE or a body or a person authorized by  
it will be free to take measures for withdrawal of its approval without consideration of any related issues and  
will be responsible arising out of such a withdrawal of its approval to the conduct of the concerned Society.

The institution by virtue of the approvals given by AICTE shall not automatically become claimant to any  
financial grant or assistance from the Central or State Government.

The institution shall observe all instructions, guidelines issued by the AICTE and its regional office regarding  
mode of selection of candidates for admissions prescribing fees and on all matters having relevance to  
maintaining high quality and standards of teaching, research, projects in the institution. No capitation shall be  
charged and no charges other than the fee fixed by the Competent Authority shall be levied on students hereby  
agreed to furnish a certificate to the effect to the last date of admissions during every academic year.

The institution shall be liable to bear all expenses payable to the students admitted to academic programs due  
to disconnection of the institution by its own will or by AICTE including all demurrages incurred due to loss  
of time already pursued by the admitted students in the programs. The Institution shall also be responsible for  
suitable demurrages to the faculty and staff recruited in it.

10. The management of the college shall fully comply with the 'SCHEME' as prescribed by the  
Supreme Court in its judgment dated 4.1.93 with regard to W.P.(c) No. 607 of 1993 in the case of Unni Krishnan  
and others vs. State of Andhra Pradesh and others and the related guidelines and criteria as may be issued by  
the AICTE, UGC or the Central Government from time to time.

11. The institution will not indulge in advertisements which could be construed as commercialization of Technical  
Education.

12. The institutions shall not collaborate or associate with any other institution or University neither Indian nor  
foreign to award one or more joint degrees or diplomas to the students admitted to the AICTE approved  
program.

13. Each institution shall submit to AICTE through its Regional Office, a list of candidates admitted to the  
approved programmes after finalizing admission (latest by August 31 of each year) giving names, percentage of  
marks in qualifying examinations and score in written test in addition to the above mentioned particulars like  
score in group discussion and interview with relative weighting and criteria of admission followed,  
constitution of admission committee in respect of M.E.A and M.C.A programmes. A declaration shall be  
submitted to the effect that no changes made in the deviation from the norms of AICTE including annual  
fees etc. in the institution.

Institute - I

1. The courses to be pursued by students shall be determined by the Institute on behalf of the  
Name of the Institute \_\_\_\_\_  
and shall be based on merit, knowledge and experience of the Institute itself.
2. The courses shall be made only after consultation between the concerned institution and AICTE and all other documents are created as per norms and guidelines of the AICTE Govt. of India Govt. and containing the affiliation from the concerned University in case of degree program. The Institute shall fulfill all specific conditions of Govt. of India Govt. in the sector and revised by the AICTE from time to time. We are aware that following in the course of AICTE is expected from time to time will be the responsibility.
3. The duration of the approved program shall be made in such a way so that no student may stay in the institution only and no more than 1 semester and again the same can be extended for not more than 1 year.
4. The approved course shall commence as per the academic calendar of the affiliated university or in the month of August of each academic year.
5. The curriculum of the course, the procedure for evaluation, assessment of students shall be in accordance with the norms prescribed by the AICTE, affiliating agency.
6. The faculty strength and quality shall be maintained by the institute as per qualifications and pay scales prescribed by AICTE from time to time. The selection of faculty shall be made by a selection committee having representation from the State Govt. University and AICTE.
7. The tuition fee and other charges shall be charged as prescribed by the competent authority (i.e. State Level Committee constituted by AICTE as indicated in GSR 476(E)). The institutions will furnish a declaration giving the actual fees collected from the students. We are aware that collecting the fees over and above that fixed by Competent Authority will be a violation leading to withdrawal of approval by AICTE.
8. All academic and physical infrastructural facilities shall be committed to be provided updated by the institute with the state of art latest equipments.
9. No new courses shall be started in the same premises and no increase shall be made in the intake of other existing courses without prior concurrence of the AICTE.
10. The Governing body and Advisory body of the institute shall be constituted as per Guidelines prescribed by the AICTE from time to time.
11. The location and name of institution shall not be changed after the date of issue of first approval letter. The name and site of the institution shall not violate The Benches and Names (Prevention of Improper Use) act 1990 of Government of India.
12. No change in the composition of society trust etc. to commence without AICTE's prior concurrence.
13. The institution has further recurring documents and records to submit to AICTE and its wings from time to time.
14. The financial and financial audit of the accounts shall be maintained for the concerned period. The account shall be submitted to the concerned AICTE office and the account and all the documents shall be sent to AICTE office at least 15 days before the due date.
